September 19th 2017

Arrival of the group at Fiumicino airport, flights arrival time to be provided.
Pick up of the group at the airport with 64 seats bus and transfer to the Hotel in Rome.
Free time and dinner in a typical Trattoria.
Back to the hotel for the night.

September 20th

Guided walking tour of the historical centre of Rome with a professional English speaking guide that will show you the most interesting spots of the city, like the Vatican State, Castel Sant'Angelo, Piazza Navona, Campo de' fiori, Piazza Venezia, Fontana di Trevi, Piazza di Spagna and Piazza del Popolo.
Free time for quick lunch, shopping and relax time at the hotel.
Dinner in the Colosseum area, night guided tour of the Colosseum and Imperial Forums, a life time experience.
Back to the hotel for the night.

September 21st

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September 23rd

Departure for Val d'Orcia, a Unesco heritage site popular in the world for its unforgettable landscapes.

Visit to the city of Pienza, known as the "perfect city" of the Italian Renaissance and also for the pecorino cheese production.

Tour of the pecorino cheese farmhouse and cheese tasting on a terrace overlooking the valley with pecorino cheese tasting, wood oven Tuscan bread, homemade jams and local cold cuts.

In the afternoon visit to the town of Montepulciano, renowned for Nobile di Montepulciano red wine and for a very old tradition of Tuscany winemaking.

Visit to a wonderful cellar overlooking 400 hectares of vineyards followed by dinner at the wine estate with wine tasting of a selection of their wines.

Back to the hotel for the night.

September 24th

Tour of the Chianti region, with visit to the small local towns in the Tuscan countryside.

Free time for lunch and afternoon visit to the city of Siena.

Walking tour of the historical centre of the town and the Siena Cathedral with a special visit to the pavement of the church, that will be uncovered for the occasion.

The pavement of the Cathedral is a unique work of art that is uncovered just in some period of the year and for some special groups.

Free time for dinner and back to the hotel for the night.

September 25th

Full day free in Cortona for shopping and relax with activities to be booked in advance.

Walk to visit Pat house and the studio.

September 26th

Departure for Florence.

Historical centre walking tour with English speaking professional guide that will show you the wonderful city of Firenze.

Visit to the Santa Marina Novella square, Florence Cathedral, tour of the ancient streets of the city, Accademia's David gallery, Ponte Vecchio, Santa Croce square and church.

Free lunch at the just restored San Lorenzo market where you will be able to buy local food products and enjoy a typical Florentine lunch.

Free time for shopping in the afternoon, transfer back to Cortona and dinner at local restaurant.

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September 27th

Departure for the Amalfi coast and arrival in Sorrento by lunch time.

Transfer to the hotel and free time for visiting the city .

Dinner in the beautiful gardens of the hotel and relaxed evening by the pool.

September 28th

Full day journey of the Amalfi coast with visit to the city of Ravello and the breathtaking Villa Rufolo.

Afternoon visit of the town of Amalfi and the Cathedral of the town, very famous for its Arabian-Norman architecture and its wonderful view of the harbour.

Dinner in a local restaurant in the small alleys of the historical centre.

Back to the hotel for the night.

September 29th

Visit to the small jewel of the city of Positano.

Positano is a cliffside village on southern Italy's Amalfi Coast. It's a well-known holiday destination with a pebble beachfront and steep, narrow streets lined with boutiques and cafes. Its Chiesa di Santa Maria Assunta features a majolica-tiled dome and a 13th-century Byzantine icon of the Virgin Mary. The famous Sentiero degli Dei hiking trail links Positano to other coastal towns.

Back in Sorrento for typical Neapolitan Pizza dinner and back to the hotel.

September 30th

Departure for Pompei and visit to the archeological sites for the day.

Afternoon arrival in Rome and transfer to the hotel for dinner and the overnight.

October 1st

Departure from Hotel Hilton Fiumicino with Hilton free shuttle on individual timings.

Check out from the hotel by 12pm.


Supplements and reductions
