Check-in in Italy is always possible from the afternoon, so please arrange your air tickets accordingly in order to avoid a long waiting time before accessing the room reserved for you. Free time to relax and get ready for our first welcome dinner at one of the most ancient Osteria in Palermo historical centre .

### **May 6<sup>th</sup>**

Morning guided visit to the vibrant centre of Palermo, a city with a huge charm and with several different faces. Start your day with a visit to the stunning Cathedral, declared Unesco heritage site in 2015, see the Byzantine chapel and the Royal Palace, a full immersion into the historical heart of this special city.

Lunch at one of the local daily market of the city Ballarò to enjoy the authentic Sicilian food coming from the roots.

Afternoon and dinner on your own to mingle with the locals and enjoy the Palermo famous movida.

### **May 7<sup>th</sup>**

Have a look at the many fascinating spaces of the Teatro Massimo, Palermo most ancient opera house opened in 1897 and considered a very interesting example of the cultural ferment of the time. Enjoy your free time for lunch at the local fish market Vucciria to immerse yourself in the real Palermitan atmosphere!

Afternoon on your own for some shopping in the typical Sicilian boutiques, something not to miss! Group dinner on the rooftop overlooking Palermo from above!

### **May 8<sup>th</sup>**

Morning departure for Cefalù, a real pearl nestled on the top of the hill overlooking a deep blue sea. Visit the stunning Cathedral and the lovely town full of small typical Sicilian bottega.

Afternoon visit to the extraordinary Taormina Greek Amphitheatre, a breath taking balcony on the Mediterranean.

Check-in at the Unahotel Capotaormina 4\*\*\*\* hotel with an enchanting view of the coast, a private beach, an infinity view saltwater pool and wellness centre .



Enjoy some free time and dine on your own at the hotel or in the very picturesque town of Taormina.

### **May 9<sup>th</sup>**

Meeting with our local guide Sonia, our Etna volcano adventure begins!

We will discover the beauty of the south side of the volcano, grab a cable car and reach the Sartorius craters and the Etna forest to enjoy a relaxed walk and immerse yourself in the peaceful nature of the Etna archeological park.

Lunch on the way and afternoon visit to the town of Acireale, very popular for its fine art colorful ceramics.

Time for some shopping and transfer to Hotel Villa Carlotta 4\*\*\*\* in Ragusa.

Group dinner at the Michelin star restaurant of the hotel with a delicious customised menu created for us.

### **May 10<sup>st</sup>**

After a nice breakfast, start your day with a morning guided tour of Ragusa Ibla, very popular for its Baroque architecture.

Ragusa Ibla is the name of the most ancient part of the historical centre of the town of Ragusa and is also famous for being a movie set for several Italian movies, like Montalbano, a quite funny Sicilian detective :)

Enjoy a relaxed afternoon by the pool at the hotel or visit the rest of the town on your own.

Free time for dinner in Ragusa and back to the hotel for the night.

### **May 11<sup>th</sup>**

Day excursions to Noto, known for its baroque architecture, the richly decorated balconies and the resembling triumphal arch, the 19th-century Porta Reale that marks the entrance to the city.

Group lunch in Marzamemi, one of the most typical fishing village of Sicily and afternoon visit to Modica, a Unesco heritage site famous for the elegance of the churches and ...for a delicious chocolate exported all over the world!

Back in Ragusa for the night and dine on your own for some relaxed time.



### **May 12<sup>th</sup>**

Departure for a full day in unforgettable Siracusa!

A full immersion in Ortigia, the ancient island where the historical part of Siracusa is located.

Ortigia is considered a small jewel on the sea and its surface does not exceed 1 square kilometre.

Siracusa is also base of an amazing archeological park called Neapolis, a natural area full of archeological sites belonging to different ages of the Siracusa history.

This park is considered one of the most important archeological site of Sicily and the Mediterranean.

Group dinner in Siracusa to enjoy the city by night and back to the hotel in Ragusa.

### **May 13<sup>th</sup>**

Morning departure for an interesting visit to Caltagirone, an inland city half way from the Western and the Eastern Sicily. The city located on the top of a hill is worldwide known for ceramic and its museum is one of the two most important ceramic sites of Italy.

In the afternoon check-in at the Il Principe di Catania 4\*\*\*\* hotel and enjoy a group dinner in town.

### **May 14<sup>th</sup>**

Begin your day meeting our guide for a morning walking tour of the city of Catania, immersing yourself in the hustle bustle of the city.

Catania is an harbour city based at the Etna footsteps whose Cathedral Baroque plasters have been declared Unesco heritage and where you will visit the famous Pescheria, the daily fish market to feel the real Sicilian every day life and savour some very local cuisine.

Dine on your own at one of the local trattoria.

### **May 15<sup>th</sup>**

Your last day in Sicily will start with a visit to the towns of Acicastello where you will be able to admire the Cyclopean Isles, a small rocky archipelago and Acitrezza, a small village with a long history of maritime activity.

Enjoy some time at the beach and join our farewell dinner by the sea!

### **May 16<sup>th</sup>**

Check- out from the hotel in Catania and Arrivederci bellissima Sicilia!

Morning transfer to Catania airport will be arranged for the group.

Customised transfers to other cities can be arranged individually with Claudia.
